- ☐ Have a ride on the Bure Valley narrow gauge railway at Hoveton & Wroxham
- ☐ Take a boat trip to discover Wroxham Broad
- ☐ Explore the pretty village of Worsted, famous for Worsted cloth, with its magnificent church and quaint village square
- ☐ See if you can spot the ghostly 'White Lady' at Worsted's village pub
- ☐ Get a taste of the Amazon at Amazonia Zoo from Roughton Road station
- ☐ Glimpse the North Sea as the train approaches Cromer
- ☐ Try a traditional dressed Cromer Crab
- ☐ Hunt for fossils at West Runton beach
- ☐ Climb some of Norfolk's highest hills at West Runton
- ☐ Join a section of the long-distance Norfolk Coast Path for a walk with stunning coastal views
