- Take a river cruise at Ipswich
- See boats bob on their moorings at Woodbridge
- Stroll along the quay at Woodbridge
- Admire Woodbridge's working Tide Mill
- Discover the treasures unearthed at Sutton Hoo anglo saxon burial site from Melton station
- Follow the Deben Valley and Alde Valley walks from Wickham Market station.
- Take a holiday at Darsham's old station house.
- Visit Saxmundham's walled garden, and maybe bring a plant home with you

- Potter around the lovely market town of Halesworth with its many shops, restaurants, pubs, and outdoor market.
- Walk through unspoilt countryside from Brampton station
- Mess about on the river with a canoe or day boat at Beccles
