Visit Chappel and gaze in awe at the 32 imposing arches of the village's Viaduct

Step back in time with steam and vintage engines at the East Anglian Railway Museum

Enjoy some refreshment in the medieval surroundings of The Swan public house, Chappel

Stand with one foot in Essex and the other in Suffolk at the border village of Bures

Spot cows grazing along the Meadow Walk at Sudbury

Enjoy views straight out of a Constable painting along the Stour Valley

Go boating on the river Stour

Follow the Stour Valley path from Bures to Workingford Mill and Church

Climb to the viewpoint at the ancient thatched Chapel of St Stephen, for a view of the Bures Dragon – but don't let him see you!

Find out about the life of Thomas Gainsborough at the Gainsborough House museum and art gallery

Cycle the four miles from Sudbury to the moated Tudor manor of Kentwell Hall
