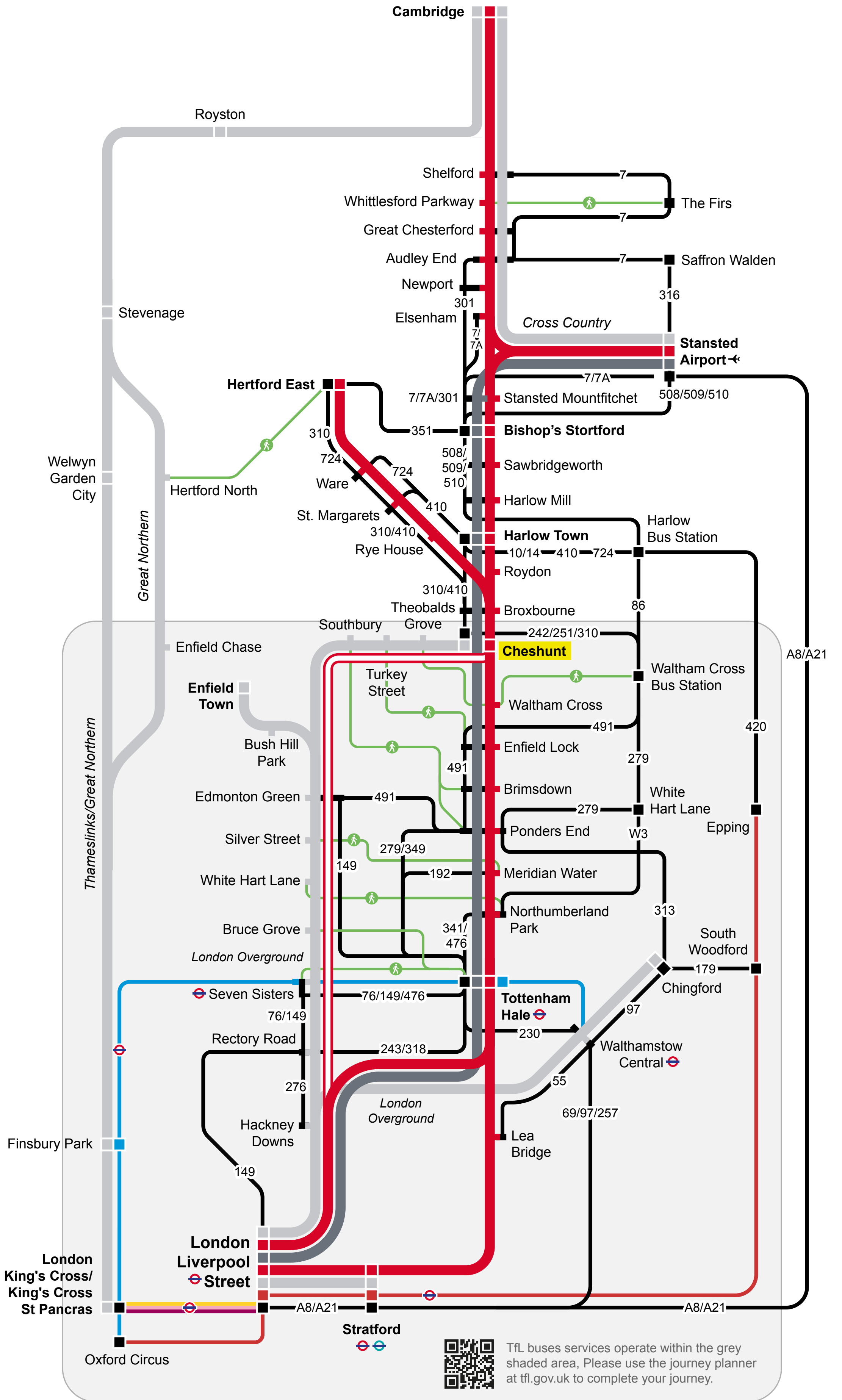

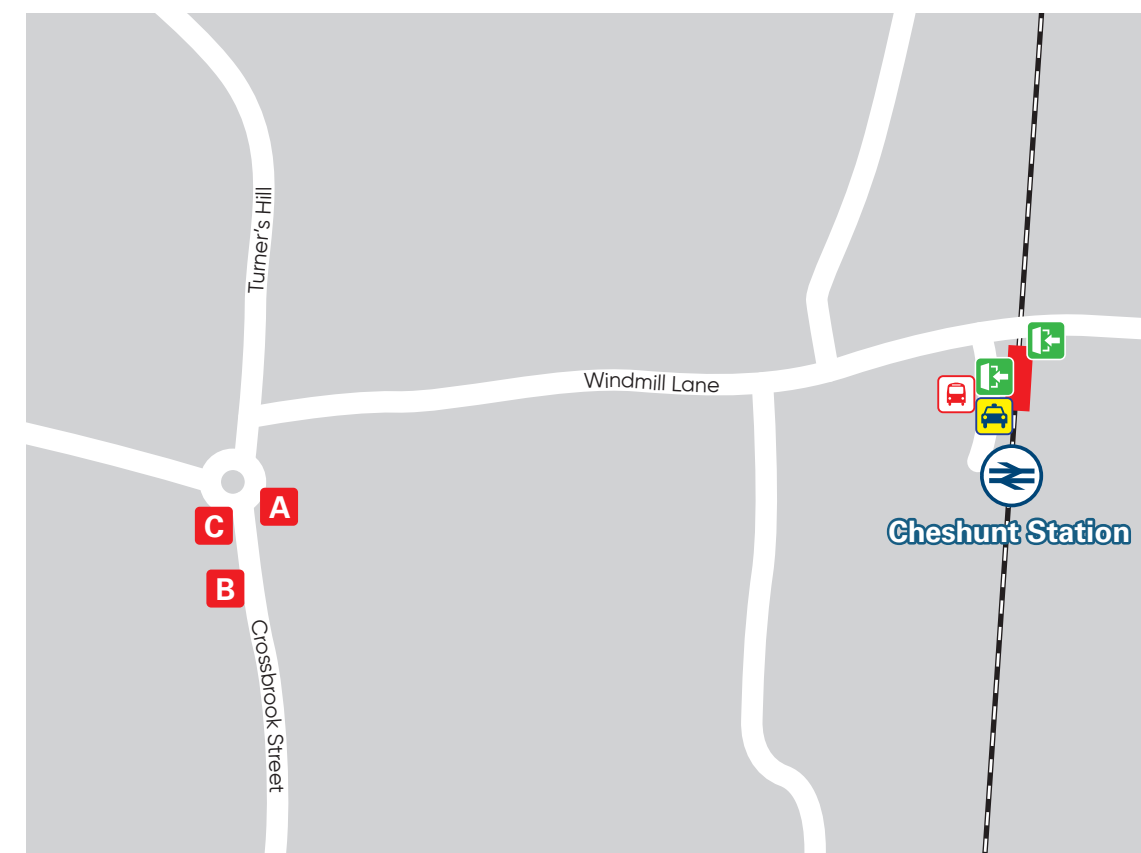


### NOTES

- Bus route 7 (Stansted Airport - Bishop Stortford) operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running once every two hours.
- Bus route 7A operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running once every two hours.
- Bus route 55 operates a daily service, with buses running every 10 minutes.
- Bus route 149 operates a daily service, with buses running every 10 minutes.
- Bus route 242 operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running every 30 minutes.
- Bus route 251 operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running every 20 minutes.
- Bus route 301 operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running every hour.
- Bus route 310 operates a daily service, with buses running every 15 minutes.
- Bus route 351 operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running once every two hours.
- Bus route 410 operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running every hour.
- Bus route 476 operates a daily service, with buses running every 10 minutes.
- Bus route 491 operates daily, with buses running every 20 minutes.
- Bus route 508 operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running every 30 minutes.
- Bus route 509 operates Mondays to Saturdays, only, with buses running every 30 minutes.
- Bus route 510 operates a daily service, with buses running every 30 minutes.
